In addition, for those who have difficulty attending the clinic, we offer home-based rehabilitation. We will offer a stable plan for rehabilitation accessible for everyone based on the needs of the individual and the state of your recovery.















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


Yoshizawa Hospital is a regional rehabilitation medical association institution as designated by the Saitama governor.

In May 2016, Yoshizawa Hospital moved to a new building. As a medical institution we have been open 57 years this year, and since opening we have been at the forefront of community healthcare, looking from the viewpoint of those with difficulties, we have exerted every effort especially in the area of medicine and nursing for the elderly,

The greatest feature of the new hospital is the relevant support system via the "Kotobuki no Sato" which is the general name for the large site at which our hospital is situated. This is the service group for Yoshizawa Hospital which provides medical care and nursing. Connected to the second floor of the hospital building is the home for elders which provides safe and comfortable housing. In addition, we are coordinated with a pharmacy and convenience store to provide various aspects of support for everyday needs. Kotobuki no Sato as a whole provides everyone in the area with beneficial services and practices comprehensive community care.

In addition, within the hospital there is a $77 \, \text{m}^2$ conference room which besides coordinating with medical care and nursing institutions is also a place for community members to interact with each other. Further, in the outer precincts of the hospital, there is a gazebo, walking course, recreational grounds etc which are free for not only patients on the path to recovery but also locals in the area.

Our role as a chronic phase medical institution

These days all facilities and services must take steps to adapt to the super aging society, but not only in the acute phase but also for chronic phase medical care the trend towards trying to return home has become clear.

In particular, for older patients to return home, rehabilitation is crucial.

In order to support living in the community, chronic phase medical care is key so a clinical environment that can respond to the individual needs of patients must be prepared and with rehabilitation from the beginning, dementia, terminal illnesses, home-based medical care and nursing etc. must also be taken into account.

In our new hospital, from the width of the hallways to the space allotted to each patient, we are more spacious than ordinary hospitals and making it an environment that is easy to recuperate in.

We are also equipped with spacious "rehabilitation rooms", the "dining hall" where you can view Mount Akagi and "bathing facilities" which are accessible to at all stages of recovery. Without overstraining, we extend our patients functions according to their aptitude and we work hard to provide a curriculum that prevents patients from becoming bedridden.
